Works Registration Process in Jigawa State

In accordance with the Jigawa State Works Registration Law (Section 5(e)(f)(g), all Contractors operating within the State are required to register to obtain their works registration certificate in compliance with the State's Regulations (www.dueprocess.jg.gov.ng). Below is a step-by-step guide to completing this process:

(Based on Due Process and Project Monitoring Bureau's Guidelines 2019, sections 5.4.2 (A), to register all categories of contractors and issuance of certificate thereof. In view of the above, the Bureau classified its mandates in doing business as follows.

Online Process

1. Documentation

The documentations required to be registered as a contractor in Jigawa State are:

- Evidence of business registration with Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC)
- RC Number
- TIN Number
- Phone number
- Email address
- Nature of business
- Company type
- Names of the Directors

2. Registration

- Make a payment of N15,000.00 at any Zenith Bank Plc branch and obtain a username and a password from the Bank
- Using the username and the password log on to the Bureau's registration portal: <https://portal.dueprocess.jg.gov.ng/>
- Fill the registration form online and upload scanned copies of the relevant documents

- Click submit

After this process your registration certificate will be printed and issued within 48 hours.

Manual Process

1. Preparation

- Your application can be completed in one day if you have the following information ready.
 - Relevant business documents, including a certificate of incorporation or business name
 - Registered Business Name
 - Business location (address)
 - Nature of the business
 - Proposed start date for the project/business
 - Company type (e.g. sole proprietorship, partnership, limited liability).
 - Names and addresses of the company's directors, if applicable.
 - Name and address of the company secretary, if applicable.
- Submit the completed form along with copies of the necessary documents at the Bureau's Headquarter.

2. Due Diligence:

- The Bureau will review your application and perform legal, regulatory, and compliance checks. This process will be completed within 48 hours.

3. Payment:

- Payment should be made to any branch of Zenith Bank Plc, Account No. 1011289787. Keep the bank teller as proof of payment and share with Bureau via email on info@dueprocess.gov.ng.

4. Certificate Collection:

- A registration certificate is generated for the applicant within 3 working days.
- The Works Registration Certificate can be collected from the Bureau's Headquarters as stated above. Collection hours are Monday to Thursday, 9 am to 3 pm, and Friday, 9 am to 12 noon, excluding public holidays. The certificate is collected via presentation of the receipt.
- Applicant can also receive certificate via email if indicated as a preference.

5. Waiver for Eligible Businesses:

- Small- and Medium-Scale Businesses eligible for a waiver of up to N5,000 during an approved SME's programme such as Covid 19 pandemic, flood support and other support initiatives by the State Government.
